

Perched on a peaceful namesake plaza fronting a 13th-century Gothic basilica, Sant Francesc Hotel Singular is a one-time stately mansion turned urban-chic stay. While decorative reminders of its storied architecture are found throughout by way of moldings, archways and top-to-toe windows, interiors bathed in swatches of black-framed ivory, taupe and tan shades are decidedly modern. The 42 design-centric rooms, each with individual touches, share the upscale color palette. Amenities include a cocktail bar, an adjoining olive tree-sprinkled courtyard, a cozy underground wellness sanctuary and a fitness zone. Meals are served at Quadrant, a stylish restaurant offering creative Mediterranean cuisine in three ambient spaces. A popular spot at sunset, the Singular Rooftop welcomes guests with a sparkling rectangular pool, a solarium, luxe loungers and cushy sofas alongside manicured shrubbery, seasonal cocktails and light bites service
